ROADMASTER REPORT: Buildings were moved from Stimpson property to our property. Amish Company was moving them (\$840). Gas Well guys are going to move the grader down to our property this week also. (no charge). Noyes Twp signs were installed at the end of building. Today Railroad wanted to know if they have permission to drive pickup trucks across the bridge on Vincent Drive. James told them yes, right now cause there is a temporary bridge that the Gas Company put in until their last day they are there. A log truck ripped the signs off the Railroad bridge. James contacted the Railroad to see if it was their responsibility to put them back up or the Townships. Railroad will get back to him. All gas wells on the lower end are closed. Moved old well truck and the old drilling rig still runs. Scrap company is taking all the tanks, which is like 2 dozen of them. They have four more wells to close. Road crew salting & plowing roads and cleaned around all fire hydrants.

There is a tank to collect any liquid coming out. Should have certificate in future.
